- 11. BM6 update: An MOU is being written between COMPRES, Stony Brook, and APS. The latest iteration was discussed.
- 12. The possibility of having a COMPRES representative for the APSUO (of the Advanced Photon Source) was discussed.
- 13. Advisory Council: This year, there will not be a meeting with the AC and the

Executive Committee at the Annual Meeting. The role and charge of the Advisory Council was discussed, with discussion to continue at future meetings.
