I attended the NSLS-II User Meeting, which included a day-long plenary session, a tour of the NSLS-II (thanks, Larry Carr), a banquet, and a second day workshop: "The Earth Laboratory: Experimental and Computational Tools and Infrastructure for Cross-cutting Earth Sciences". I had informal discussions about COMPRES and NSLS-II with John Hill, Qun Shen, Zhenxian Liu, Don Weidner, and Lars Ehm. Zhenxian Liu and I discussed the possibility of workshop next year in anticipation of FIS coming online. Updates on FIS/MET completion time and user time: setup complete one year from now. Commissioning and User experiments ~2 years (May 2018). HEX beamline update: plan to be finished and ready for users in five years (2021/2022). XPD MAP to be operational later this year.
